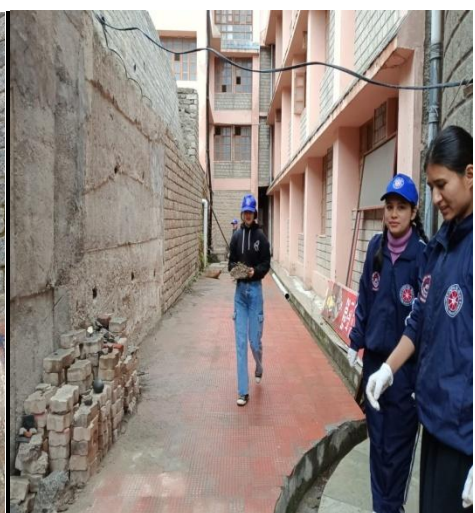

Day: 1

Tuesday, 18th February 2025

The Seven Days NSS Camp started on 18th February 2025 in Govt. College Reckong Peo. It was formally inaugurated by the Chief Guest, Sh. Janak Negi, Associate Prof. of the College with programme officer Dr. Sher Singh. The NSS Programme Officer, Dr. Sher Singh welcomed the Chief Guest, faculty members, press members present and the participating NSS volunteers. The inaugural session started with the lighting of lamp and Lakshya Geet. Thereafter, the NSS Programme Officer, Dr. Sher Singh gave a speech on the importance and relevance of NSS in colleges and other educational institutes. He also gave an outline of the major activities that were proposed to be organized during the one-week long camp.
