About the College

Thakur Sen Negi Govt. College Reckong Peo is situated amidst the beautiful ranges of Himalayas and beneath the blessings of mountain peak Kinner Kailash. It is a pioneering institute for higher education at Reckong Peo District Kinnaur, which is one of the three tribal areas of Himachal Pradesh. The college came into being on 16th August 1994 with an objective to impart higher education to the people of this tribal area. The institute is named after a philanthropist and social worker Thakur Sen Negi, the son of the soil, who was the first Chief Secretary and three times elected speaker of Himachal Pradesh Vidhan Sabha. It was his dream that an institute of higher learning may be opened in this tribal district so that the students should not have to go Rampur, Shimla, Solan, Chandigarh or elsewhere for seeking higher education.

The institute has constantly endeavored to accomplish excellence in diverse areas such as academics, sports, NCC, NSS, cultural activities, Rovers & Rangers and other co-curricular activities. The vision of the college is to spearhead cutting edge education, implement advanced technology, sense of humanity and instill moral values and ethics among students besides, their all round development. The institution aims to develop varied faculties for learning which can draw out the best from students in terms of mind, body and spirit. The mission of the institution is VIDYA JANAM JYOTI 'Vidya' means knowledge, science, learning, scholarship and philosophy, 'JANAM' means consciousness, cognizance, knowing, understanding, becoming acquainted with proficiency and sacred knowledge, especially knowledge derived from meditation on the higher truth of religion and philosophy which teaches man how to understand his own nature and communion with the 'Supreme.' 'JYOTI' means light as the divine principle of life, source of intelligence, a type of freedom, bliss and victory.

The college is affiliated to HP University Shimla and accredited with 'B' grade by NAAC Bengaluru. Presently 13 subjects in Arts and 5 subjects in Science streams are being offered at undergraduate level. Students can also pursue B.Com degree. In addition to this there are Post Graduate courses in History and Political Science. Students may also opt for Self-financing courses like BCA and PGDCA and diploma/certificate courses in Tourism and Disaster Management. There is an IGNOU Study Centre for distant learners. The institute remains in the fore front in rendering services to the society by engaging students in service, betterment and welfare of the community. Cleanliness campaigns and rallies, various awareness campaigns, blood donation camps, collection of funds for relief and rescue works etc. are regular features of the college. Training camps for skill enhancement, workshops/seminars on communication and soft skills are organized at regular intervals.

Scholarships

The central and state government provide monetary help to various categories of students to fulfil their educational dreams and goals. During the session a total no. of 60 students (15 boys, 45 girls) applied for scholarship schemes under Indira Gandhi Utkrishth Chhatravriti Yojna, IRDP Scholarship Scheme. Kalpna Chawla Scholarship Plan, Post – Matric SC Scholarship Scheme, Post – Matric ST Scholarship Scheme and OBC Scholarship Scheme. The amount of scholarship schemes was credited online in the bank account of students. Prof. Kamlesh Kumar Assistant Prof. of Pol. Science is In-charge, Scholarships.

College Library

Library is an indispensable part of an educational institution. The college library has a collection of 10835 books on different subjects and 4209 reference books. It subscribes 06 daily newspapers and 5 magazines. It is connected with INFLIBNET and SOUL 2.0 software facilities. Books are issued to students regularly and a complete record of books issued/returned is maintained. Students and visitors put their signature on the visitors' register daily. Students coming from economically weaker section of society are provided books for full academic session under Book Bank Scheme.

Indira Gandhi National Open University (IGNOU)

Our college is also a study centre of IGNOU since 1999. More than 32 programmes (degree and diplomas) are available with the study centre. The motive of the centre is to provide distant learning; knowledge and employability to the people of this tribal district particularly to girls and to those who are unable to seek formal education because of working in government, public or private sectors or being self- employed. The programmes, courses and curriculum of IGNOU are highly innovative and designed in such a way that they fulfil all requirements of employment, skills and knowledge. B.A, B.Com and B.A in Tourism, M.A degrees in History, Hindi, English, Political Science, Sociology, Public Administration, Economics, Sanskrit and M.Com etc. are available for students. The total enrolment of study centre is 571. Dr. Vidya Bandu Negi is Co-ordinator and Dr. Jeevan Masoi is Assistant Co-ordinator.

Information and Technological Education & Language Lab

The Institution provides information and technological education to all students. Class-wise/stream-wise time-table is displayed for the convenience of students. There are two computer labs with 53 computers, printers and scanners for students and teachers. An English

Language Lab is also established in one of these labs in which basic training and knowledge are imparted to students to enhance communication and soft skills.

National Science Scheme (NSS)

The motto of NSS is “Not Me but You”. The aim of NSS is to understand the community in which they work. NSS promotes national integration and sense of social responsibility. There is one unit of NSS and 100 Volunteers are enrolled in it. During the session under cleanliness drive volunteers uprooted cannabis plants, bushes and hedges in the college, DC office, CJM court and Fire brigade premises. During International Youth Day, volunteers planted saplings at girls’ hostel. Volunteers also attended one workshop during ‘World Consumer Day’ at DC office and the other during ‘Youth Parliament’ organised by Nehru Yuva Kendra Reckong Peo. Seven Day Special Camp was organised w.e.f. 14th to 19th March 2022 which was attended by 60 students. Volunteers adopted Khawangi village where they cleaned natural water resources, repaired pathways and sensitized villagers about cleanliness, breast feeding, child nutrition, health and hygiene and nutritious food for pregnant women. The volunteers also removed pebbles, stones, plastic bags etc. from the college premises and playground. Different activities like declamation, workshops, cultural, yoga and meditation etc. were organized during this special camp. Assistant Professors Dharam Kirti Negi, Yash Paul Sharma and Sachin Bhardwaj delivered valuable lectures on different topics as resource persons. Mr. Shanta Kumar Negi, Assistant Professor of History is the Programme Officer of NSS.

Unnat Bharat Abhiyan(UBA)

The institution is registered under Unnat Bharat Abhiyan, an initiative of MHRD and follows its instructions and guidelines. We adopted 5 villages of district Kinnaur during the academic session 2021-2022 and carried out many activities in these villages as per directions of MHRD. An amount of Rs.50000/- was received from the ministry under UBA during this session. Prof. Dharm kirti Negi is the Programme Co-ordinator of UBA.

Mahatma Gandhi National Council for Rural Education (MGNCRE)

The institution is constantly working for community service, welfare and development through education and is registered under MGNCRE, an initiative of MHRD. District Green Champion Award was presented to the institution by MGNCRE on 11th April 2022 through DC Kinnaur. Dr. Gian Chand Sharma, Assistant Prof. of English is the District Co-ordinator of MGNCRE.

Old Students Association (Alumni Association)

The Old Students’ Association (OSA) of the college is continuously working for the growth and development of institution. It is very co-operative and takes keen interest in various activities of the college. The association was registered under Society Act 2002 on 21st Aug. 2021. Mr. Dharm Kirti Negi, Assistant Prof. of Geography is the Member Secretary and Mr. Mukesh Kumar is the President of OSA.

Disaster Management Cell

The institution has a very active and effective Disaster Management Cell. As per the direction of the Directorate of Higher Education, Shimla, regular monitoring mechanism and college safety programmes were developed. A detailed report of Disaster Management Plan, list of various committees constituted under the plan, purpose of the plan, college arrangement, human resources and detail of activities organized during the session 2021-2022 along with documentary proof were submitted to the directorate on 6th July 2021. Prof. Dharm Kirti Negi, Assistant Prof. of Geography is Co-ordinator of the cell.

All India Survey on Higher Education (AISHE)

The college is registered under All India Survey on Higher Education (AISHE) The institutional details and data for the academic session 2020-2021 were prepared and submitted in Dec. 2021 in the web portal of AISHE. Dr. Brij Mohan Prajapati, Assistant Prof. of Physics is the Nodal Officer of AISHE.

Rovers & Rangers

Rovers and Rangers unit was constituted in 2008. There are 25 rovers (girls) and 25 rangers (boys) enrolled in this unit. The unit carried out many campaigns and drives like 'Follow Traffic Rules', 'Voters Awareness Rally', 'Save Girl Child,' Education for Girls', 'Covid-19 Protocol', 'Legal Awareness Campaign', 'Cleanliness Campaign', etc. Rovers and Rangers also participated in 'Prabhat Feri' a rally on legal rights of public at Reckong Peo organised by District Legal Services-PAN-India Awareness Campaign. The rovers and rangers also participated in different cleanliness and societal activities organized by college on 13th Oct. 2021. Mr. Bhagwan Singh Negi, Assistant Prof. of Public Administration is the Leader of Rovers & Ranger.

National Cadet Corps (NCC)

'Unity and Discipline' is the motto of NCC and therefore it aims at developing character, good fellowship, discipline, a secular outlook, the spirit of adventure and ideals of selfless service among youth. It is needless to say that NCC also provides an environment conducive to motivate young Indians to join armed forces. One wing of NCC was established in our college during the academic session 2020-2021, presently it comprises of 36 cadets, 20 boys and 16 girls. NCC unit is working under 8HP BN NCC Rampur (with total strength of 54 cadets, 18 cadets are enrolled every year) Mr. Mohan Singh Negi, Assistant Prof. of Political Science is CTO/ANO NCC. 14 cadets of NCC attended General Camp at 8 HP BN NCC Rampur w.e.f. 8th to 14th Nov. 2021. Cadets also observed International Yoga day on 21st June. Under the able guidance of Mr. Mohan Singh Negi, ANO NCC, they performed various asanas of yoga in college ground.

Internal Quality Assurance cell (IQAC)

Our college is accredited with 'B' grade by NAAC Bengaluru in May 2016. The college aims at improving the quality of teaching- learning, skill enhancement, all round development of students, use of ICT and modern tools of teaching – learning etc. The IQAC is continuously working for organizing indoor and outdoor activities in the institute. During the session 2021-2022, many co-curricular, sports and cultural activities were organized in the college with the assistance of IQAC. The cell successfully prepared and submitted Annual Quality Assurance Reports (AQAR's) of previous academic session, i.e. 2016-2017, 2017-2018, 2018-2019, 2019-2020 and 2020-2021. These reports have been accepted and the next phase of accreditation i.e. IQA and Self-Study Report are being prepared. Ms. Balam Negi, Assistant Prof. of Hindi is the Co-ordinator of IQAC.

University Grants Commission (UGC)

The institution is included under 2B & 12F list of UGC and eligible to seek grants under different heads and schemes of University Grants Commission. During the academic session 2021-2022 no grants were received from UGC by the institution Dr. Gian Chand Sharma, Assistant Prof. of English is co-ordinator of UGC.

Self Financing Programmes

Under Self-financing Programme BCA & PGDCA courses are being offered to the students. 40 seats each are allotted to these programmes. There are 30 subsidized seats in each course and 10 non-subsidized seats (in each) are offered. During the academic session 2021-2022, 6 seats in BCA and 9 seats in PGDCA were filled up. Dr. Brij Mohan Prajapati is Co-ordinator of Self-Financing Programmes.

Add-on Courses

Under career oriented scheme of UGC, Add-on course on Travel & Tourism Management and Disaster Management are being run in the institution. Geographical Society of the college organized one day workshop on 'Disaster Management'. A mock drill on disaster, rescue operation and earthquake etc. was organized in the college for students on 26th Nov. 2021. Mr. Dharam Kirti Negi, Assistant Prof. of Geography is the coordinator of Add-on courses.

Girls' Hostel

The institution has a girls' hostel with intake capacity of 60 students. It is equipped with modern facilities. 32 girls are residing in the hostel. A fresher's party was organized on 25th Oct. 2021 to welcome the new entrants. Dr Vidya Bandhu Negi Principal of the college was the Chief Guest on this occasion. Several cultural items were performed to entertain students and guests. Farewell function for outgoing students was also organized on 4th March 2022. Mr. Jank Singh Negi, Associate Prof. of Sociology was the Chief Guest on this occasion. Folk dance, duet dance, solo song and mimicry etc. were performed by the girls. Ms. Shailja Negi Thakur, Assistant Prof. of English was the Warden of Hostel.
