These decisions were taken during a review meeting, held recently on the HPU campus under the chairmanship of Vice-Chancellor Mahavir Singh. During the meeting, an action taken report (ATR) of an international conference organised by TS Negi Government College, Reckong Peo, was discussed in detail.

The VC said the conference was a milestone for the college as well as for the university.



The international conference served not only as a platform for academic exchange but also prominently showcased the potential of higher education in the remote mountainous regions of Himachal Pradesh at the global level," Chand said.


